CIRCULAR

Sub: Implementation of Government's decisions on the recommendations of the 7th CPC-revision of Pension of pre-2016 pensioners/family pensioners etc. -procedural actions for revision: reg.

Reference GSI, CHQ Circular issued under letter No.DDG(P)/Circular/2017, dated 08.08.2017 vide which detailed instructions were issued for implementation of Government's decisions on the recommendations of the 7th CPC-revision of Pension of pre-2016 pensioners/family pensioners with further directions to submit monthly status report in the attached proforma showing total number of cases requiring revision, number of cases revised and pending cases with reasons.

Now Ministry of Mines vide their e-mail dated 13.09.2017 intimated that a review meeting regarding revision of pre-2016 pension cases was held in the chamber of FA. In the meeting the FA directed that all the pension cases need to be revised before Diwali. The PAO has submitted a data, which is enclosed with this Circular for perusal. As per their records total 14,286 cases for revision of pension from GSI are pending. Out of which only 2853 cases have been finalized by PAO and at present 11,433 cases are pending. But the pending cases submitted by the GSI at the time of review meeting of the Secretary held on 04.09.2017 do not tally with the figures submitted by PAO for which the FA, Ministry of Mines, New Delhi has desired to tally the cases with the figures submitted to the PAO and the discrepancies should be sorted out. Further, **CCA has informed that on an average 15 minutes is required to settle one pension case.** The Secretary, Ministry of Mines, New Delhi directed that at least 8,000 cases needs to be settled by GSI in order to complete the revision of pension cases before Diwali.


In order to complete all the pending revision of pension cases you may put in place sufficient number of staff dealing with the revision of pension cases. Daily target should be given to all the officials assigned with this task and daily report of the same to be taken by the HOO of the Regions/GSITI/State Unit/CHQ of GSI. Ministry of Mines, New Delhi has also enclosed a proforma for daily reporting of the work done on the day to be sent by 10:00 hrs. next day. Accordingly, all the HsOO of the Regions/GSITI/State Unit of GSI should furnish the information to the HOO, GSI, CHQ, Kolkata by 09:00 hrs. who will consolidate the information and furnish the same to the Secretary, Ministry of Mines, New Delhi by 10:00 hrs. in all working days.

Since, the matter is very serious in nature, all the ADsG/DDsG of the Regions/GSITI/State Unit of GSI may take review on daily basis, taking the officers to the task, who are not completing the targets given. It has also been desired that in view the large number of cases pending, retired officers, who are proficient in the above task and can handle properly may be hired to perform this task and their performance to be monitored by giving daily task and reviewing their performance on daily basis. The Secretary, Ministry of Mines, New Delhi has also informed that serious view would be taken against the officers showing laxity in performance of their duty. All the ADsG/DDsG/of the Regions/GSITI/State Unit of GSI may take action accordingly.

It is, therefore, desired that the matter should be taken very seriously and it would be ensured that all the pending revision cases of pre-2016 Pension/Family Pension are finalized before Diwali.
