

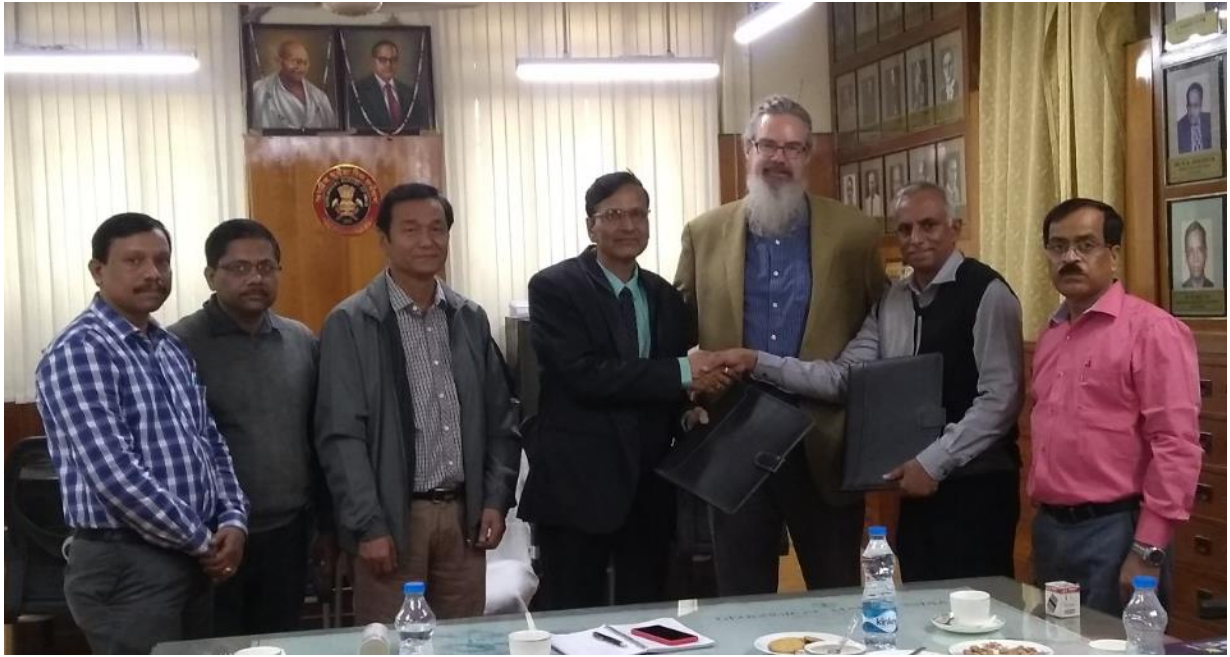
Signing of Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) between IDPeX Private Limited and GSI for “interpreting the existing legacy data for identifying the potential areas for conducting detailed heliborne surveys” held at Geological Survey of India, CHQ, Kolkata on 18th January, 2019

A Memorandum of agreement has been signed between Geological Survey of India, represented by the Director General, Dr. Dinesh Gupta and Shri S. Karunakar Rao of IDPeX Private Limited; the consortium of Datacode, Nagpur, India; Paterson, Grant & Watson Limited (PGWL), Toronto, Canada and IGS (International Geoscience Services) Ltd., Nottingham, United Kingdom for interpreting the existing legacy data over an area of 1,35,422 Sq km which includes legacy data of GSI and data acquired by Geoscience Australia for Government of Odisha for identifying the potential areas for conducting detailed heliborne surveys, preparation detailed project report (DPR), inviting Expression of Interest (EOI) from potential PIAs, Global Tender Management and Technical Supervision and Quality Control Management of the entire project.
