Ref.: VAQ recommendations of Theme-7 (Enhancing Visibility of GSI), Para-40 (vii)

With reference to the Office order no. 01/VAQ/IMPLEMENT/TH-7/M-IIIB/CHQ/2018-19 dated 29.01.19 (**Annx-I**) it is to mention that-

1. The Regional ADG & HODs/ DDG-RSAS/ DDG-M&CSD/ DDG-TI/ DDG-DGCO/ NMH-I, II, III and IV should nominate **ONLY** three officers each.
2. In case, the paper is authored by more than one officer, only the **First author** of the paper should be nominated.
3. Title of the paper, year of publication, name of the journal (where the paper was published **in 2018**) should also be mentioned for all nominated officers. A soft copy of the paper published should be sent.
4. All the final nominations should reach to the office of DG, GSI by **14th February 2019** positively by email to dg.gsi@gov.in and ddg.m3b@gsi.gov.in For further clarification please contact any of these IP nos.: 01044/ 01077.

OFFICE ORDER

In compliance of one of the VAQ recommendations of Theme-7 (Enhancing Visibility of GSI), Para-40 (vii) on “*Establish a credit-based mechanism for generating articles/ short communication / case studies from all field and lab related projects, incentives for officers who publishes papers at least in the form of recognition as the Young Scientist Award which can be conferred during GSI Day.....*”; it has been decided to confer appreciation to the young scientists (below the age of 35 of GSI) by the DG, GSI/ ADGs of Regions on Foundation Day of GSI, for publication of their research papers in peer reviewed **Indian journals including Indian Journal of Geosciences (IJG)** – an in-house quarterly publication of GSI. The modalities for implementation of this recommendation is given below for kind perusal and further necessary action by all concerned:

1. Papers published in **Indian journals** including **IJG** during the calendar year 2018 should only be considered. Articles in press or articles accepted should not be taken into consideration.
2. Paper published as an outcome of FS items should be given preference.
3. Project supervisor/ Divisional head may nominate/ propose name of the officers to the Regional ADG & HODs/ DDG-RSAS/ DDG-M&CSD/ DDG-TI/ DDG-DGCO.
4. The Regional ADG & HODs/ DDG-RSAS/ DDG-M&CSD/ DDG-TI/ DDG-DGCO would constitute a committee, preferably with one or two external experts, for selection of three officers from the list of nominated candidates. The selection of the deserving officers should be made transparent.
5. The Regional ADG & HODs/ DDG-RSAS/ DDG-M&CSD/ DDG-TI/ DDG-DGCO **each** may finally nominate three numbers of officers for appreciation.
6. Final nominations of the three officers posted at Central Facilities (NCEGR and Mission-III, CHQ) should be submitted by NMH-IV and NMH-III respectively, following the selection process as mentioned above.

7. Nomination of officers posted in PSS, CHQ may be proposed by Director/ DDG-PSS to the ADG-PSS for final selection of three officers following the same process mentioned above.

Nominations from all the offices as mentioned above should reach the office of DG, GSI by 14th February 2019 positively by email to dg.gsi@gov.in and ddg.m3b@gsi.gov.in.
