Circular on submission of Abstracts for 36th IGC 2020

Ref: IA&IGC/abstract_36th IGC/GSI/CHQ/2018 dated 14.11.2018 (uploaded in portal along with guidelines)

The 36th International Geological Congress is scheduled to be held at New Delhi from 2nd to 8th March 2020 and all the GSI officers have already been requested to be in readiness with good quality geoscientific abstracts.

As per 2nd Circular of 36th IGC (www. 36igc.org), all abstracts must be prepared and submitted in the required format as per the instructions on the 36th IGC website (ref: 2nd circular in www. 36igc.org). Abstracts must be limited to 250 words. Tables, figures, references and other graphics will not be accepted in abstracts. The window for abstract submission will open in January 2019 and closes on 31st August, 2019. Authors are permitted to submit only one abstract for oral presentation, but may submit multiple abstracts for e-posters and be non-presenting co-authors of other oral presentations. Abstracts must be submitted by the first author presenting (oral or poster) only

DG GSI has advised to **avail Super Early Bird Registration of 36th IGC only** which will opens from **15th February 2019 onwards**. In order to complete the selection procedure for abstract submission from GSI, within a limited time, all the geoscientists of GSI are requested to submit their Abstract, Extended Abstract along with relevant documents (as mentioned in circular from IA&IGC dated 14.11.2018) to their respective Regional Publication Divisions through proper channel **immediately, if not already submitted**. Officers posted in CHQ/NCEGR should submit their Abstract and Extended Abstract to Publication Division, CHQ, Kolkata in directorpid@gsi.gov.in through proper channel. Maximum file size for submission should not exceed 10 MB and all submitted abstracts must have a common subject of "IGC 2020 Abstract Submission - Theme No: " in e-mail communication, *include subtheme also.*

The abstracts will be thoroughly reviewed/ scrutinised/ modified by respective Publication Divisions. All the abstracts thus approved from Regions/CHQ should reach the Publication Division, CHQ, Kolkata **on or before 22nd February, 2019 positively** for placing before the Evaluation Committee constituted by the DG, GSI.
