PARTICIPATION OF GSI, SU: ARUNACHAL PRADESH IN WORKSHOP ON
“CAREER OPPORTUNITIES AS GEOLOGIST” AT RAJIV GANDHI UNIVERSITY,
DOIMUKH, PAPUMPARE, ARUNACHAL PRADESH

In pursuance of the Bhuvisamvad program of Ministry of Mines, Government of India, a workshop was organized by Department of Geology, Rajiv Gandhi University on “Career opportunities as Geologists” at RGU campus on 07.05.2019. This workshop was planned during the interaction meeting held with the faculties of Department of Geology, Rajiv Gandhi University (RGU), Arunachal Pradesh during the month of July, 2018 where participants were exposed to various geological activities of GSI, its contribution to the society and economy of the country and also providing technical guidance to the students.

In this workshop, officers from Geological Survey of India, State Unit: Arunachal Pradesh were invited as Resource Persons for academic interactions with the students and faculties, to share their experiences as geoscientist and to motivate the students. It was attended by Prof. Saket Kushwaha, Vice-Chancellor, Rajiv Gandhi University as chairman, Prof. Nishamani Kar as Co-ordinator (RGU), Dr. P.K.Singh, Director and Sh. Hiruj Saikia, Senior Geologist (GSI), Dr. A. A. Laskar, Head of Department, Department of Geology, RGU, other faculty members and about 30 nos of students.

The workshop was aimed and focused on encouraging the students to make career in Geology. Dr. P K Singh, Director, GSI, Itanagar delivered a lecture on “*Scope and career opportunities as Geologist*”. In his lecture he briefed about the various opportunities in the subject of Geology and encouraged the students for their dedication to the subject and their future career as Geologist. Dr. Singh also mentioned contributions and activities of GSI in India and in the state of Arunachal Pradesh. He also explained on the usage of various field instruments, methodology of work and scope of work in Geological Survey of India. Sh. Hiruj Saikia, Senior Geologist delivered a lecture on “Geology and tectonics of Arunachal Pradesh” and explained the Geology of Arunachal Pradesh in context to northeast India. The students were exposed to the various geological domains of Arunachal Pradesh, formation of the Himalayas, the Himalayan thrust and fold systems, different group of rocks and their stratigraphy and major mineral prospects in Arunachal Pradesh.

About 20 nos of rocks / mineral / palaeontological samples were submitted to the HOD, Deptt. Of Geology, Rajiv Gandhi University, Arunachal Pradesh and extended promise to help them in establishing museum Department of Geology, RGU .

Prof. Saket Kushwaha, VC, RGU appreciated the efforts by officers of GSI. The students and faculties participated in the workshop with zeal and interest. They interacted and appreciated the technical guidance given to them during the lecture sessions.
