**CIRCULAR**

Recently, it has been observed that the officers associated with Mission-IV RP items are facing problem in doing field work as per the directives vide circular No. 195/19/C&OD/TC/NMHIV/2015; dated 20/05/2019. The matter was thoroughly re-examined at the highest level in CHQ and considering the genuine difficulties faced by the officers in executing the field works in M-IV RP items, a flexible and effective norm, as regards to field stay, has been approved by the competent authority which will come into effect immediately.

The modified norms are as follows-

- (i) Officers associated with RP items of Mission-IV with minimum 30 days of field work should execute the field work in two field trips.
- (ii) Officers associated with RP items of Mission-IV with minimum 60 days of field work should execute the field work in three field trips.
- (iii) One extra trip may be allowed, in exceptional cases, with prior approval of the ADG & HOD/ADG & NMH-IV/DDG & RMH, as the case may be, for both the categories as mentioned above.

This Circular, in partial modification to the earlier one, is being issued with the approval of the competent authority.
