

**GSI, WR COMMISSIONED BOYLES C6T HYDROSTATIC DRILL RIG AT DRILL SITE
ON 11th OCTOBER 2019.**

Boyles C6T Hydrostatic Drilling Rig with 1000 m capacity in NQ/NO has been procured for the GSI, Western Region, Jaipur from M/s Epiroc Mining India Limited, Pune and commissioned at Urja Ka Khera in Bhilwara district of Rajasthan by the Dy. D.G. & HOD, Western Region on 11/10/2019.

Western Region has inducted fully hydrostatic drilling rig in the fleet of drilling rigs of Engineering Division, GSI as part of modernization and deployment of high tech drilling machines. Unit 19HY10007, having this C6T hydrostatic drill, has been deployed to undertake drilling for preliminary exploration for base metal in Urja Ka Khera area, south of Agucha deposit in Bhilwara district of Rajasthan. This hydrostatic drilling rig was commissioned at borehole no. RJUK-01.

The service engineer of Epiroc will impart field training to the drill crew at the drill site as per the Job Order to familiarize them with various functions and troubleshooting of the drill rig. Expert from Epiroc will be conducting class room and on site training to GSI officials at Urja Ka Khera from 14/10/2019 to 18/10/2019.
