**Minutes of OAC\_AP\_2019 20\_2<sup>nd</sup> Meeting of State Unit Andhra Pradesh. GSI,  
Southern Region held on 20-09-2019**

The Operational Advisory Council meeting of State Unit: Andhra Pradesh was held on 20-09-2019 under the Chairmanship of Shri R. P. Nagar, Deputy Director General, SU: Andhra Pradesh. The proceedings of the meeting are as follows:

2.1.0	<b>Welcome address</b>
2.1.1	Shri Prasun Gosh, Director (G) extended warm welcome to the Dy. Director General, SU: AP and Chairman, Shri R. P. Nagar, Shri K.R Pillay, HOO, SU: AP&T, Shri T.K. Prabhakar, Suptdg. Chemist, Chemical Division, Southern Region and Dr. V. Ramamurthy, Suptdg. Geophysicist, Southern Region, Supervisory Officers of SU: AP and all the participant officers of SU: AP to the 2 <sup>nd</sup> OAC meeting for FS2019-20. He sought valuable suggestions and meaningful interaction on various aspects before requesting the Chairman to initiate the proceedings.
2.1.2	Shri R. P. Nagar, Chairman and Dy. D.G., SU: AP welcomed to Shri K. R. Pillay, Director (G), Shri T. K. Prabhakar, Suptdg. Chemist, Chemical Division, Southern Region and Dr. S. Srinivas, Suptdg. Geophysicist, Southern Region, Supervisory Officers of SU: AP and all other participants to the meeting. The proceedings were initiated with permission of chairman after confirming the minutes of last OAC meeting.
2.2.0	<b>Review of action taken of 1<sup>st</sup> OAC meeting for FS 2019-20 held on 20-06-2019</b>
2.2.1	<p>During discussion of para No. 1.3.0 of minutes of 1<sup>st</sup> OAC meeting Dr. Apurba Banerjee, Supt Geologist informed that only 89 sample analysis result out of 479 core samples of Devada Block is pending from chemical laboratory, SR. Another 42 samples will be submitted by 4<sup>th</sup> October.</p> <p>Shri T.K. Prabhakar, Suptdg. Chemist, Chemical Division, SR, agreed to provide all the 131 samples results by 20<sup>th</sup> October 2019.</p> <p>Shri Prasun Gosh, Director TC, requested Dr. Apurba Banerjee, to advice the officers to submit report by 20th November 2019.</p> <p><b>(Action: Dr. Apurba Banerjee, Supt Geologist and Shri T. K. Prabhakar, Suptdg. Chemist)</b></p> <p>Shri Prasun Gosh, Director TC enquired the status of submission of detailed report on REE bearing minerals of STM item in Gooty area which was promised in last 1<sup>st</sup> RAC meeting informed the house that the final report has already been submitted and report regarding petrological evidence has been incorporated within this final report. Dy.D.G,SU: AP advised Dr. Banerjee to provide the report of petrological evidence on REE.</p> <p>Shri R. P. Nagar,Dy. D. G advised all supervisory officers to provide the requirement of equipment for the betterment of geological studies and submit the requisition to Shri V. S. Chowdary, Director for further action. Sri Tarun Koley informed the house that one stereoscopic microscope is required. Shri Srinivasa Chowdary has informed that one field microscope is also required. Shri V. Rammurthy, Supt Geophysicist appraised the house that portable Gamma ray spectrometer are available with Geophysics Division, SR. They can be issued to field officers for two to three days' traverse to measure radiation from suspected rocks containing radioactive minerals like U, Th. Dy.D.G requested all supervisory officers to advise their officers to plan traverse accordingly.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"><b>(Action: All supervisory officers)</b></p>

	<p>Regarding discussion of para. no 1.6.3 Shri S. Venkateswar Rao, Supt Geologist informed the house that Sri Aruni Guha, Geologist has not been submitted his work plan. DDG, SU: AP asked Shri S. Venkateswar Rao, Supt Geologist to communicate this matter to office regarding this matter.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>(Action: Shri S. Venkateswar Rao, Supt Geologist)</b></p> <p><b>Shri Apurba Banerjee, Supt Geologist</b> informed the house that in Devada block total 1539 m drilling has been done. In Borehole No ADBN-4, from 1.5m to 98m thick mineralization zone is encountered. He also informed that total 4 mineralised zone has been intersected and BH drilling in 1<sup>st</sup>,2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> line has been completed and targets achieved as per NQT.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>(Action: Shri Apurva Banerjee, Supt Geologist)</b></p> <p>Shri S. Venkateswar Rao, Supt Geologist informed the house that drilling in Udaigiri Completed on 31<sup>st</sup> of July, 2019 and Camp is closed on 9<sup>th</sup> Aug, 2019. He also informed the house that total 535 meter of BH drilling has been done and all data regarding chemical analysis has been received on 12th November,2019. He also informed the house that the report will be submitted by 12th Oct, 2019.</p> <p>Sri K. R. Pillay informed the house that the spillover of NGCM item has been completed NQT targets on 22nd July,2019 and all samples submitted to chemical division.</p>
2.3.0	<b>Discussion of agenda Items:</b>
2.3.1	<p><b>Progress/Highlights of work in FS:2019-20</b></p> <p><b>Shri Srikrishna Yadav</b> informed the house that he has 3 ME items which have been initiated</p> <p>About item in Veldurthy(25483) he informed that 5 drilling parties has visited the area. They have given feedback that there is no problem in drilling as the area is cultivation land but due to rainy season drilling can not be initiated right now.</p> <p>Regarding Gandikota item (26052) he informed the house that one Geophysical Component (Palaeomagnetic study) has to be added in NQT of OCBIS. He also informed that lab is in nagpur hence samples will be analysed in Nagpur.In this regard Dr. V. Ramamurthy, Suptdg. Geophysicist suggested the house that CS <b>with orientaton</b> has to be collected for palaeomagnetic study.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>(Action: Sri Srikrishna Yadav, Supt Geologist)</b></p> <p><b>Sri Tarun Koley</b> informed the house that he has one STM item and one ITM item which have already been initiated.He also informed the house that STM item in Rayadurg (24975), mapping of 6 Sq km area has already been completed. 4 nos. of fluid inclusion study is in progress. <b>(Action: Sri Tarun Koley, Supt Geologist)</b></p> <p><b>Smt Pinki Yadav</b> informed the house that she has two GCM items. Among which one item Tiruvannamalai and Villupuram (25417) has been initiated and right now work is in progress by Mrs Mahima .K as another officer is in PLT training from 17<sup>th</sup> Sept,2019. She also informed that 24 unite cell samples have been collected.</p> <p>One item Tiruvannamalai and Villupuram (25419), will be initiating from 21<sup>st</sup> Sept. She informed the house that due to Toughpad related issue field has been delayed. In this regard Sri Prasun Ghosh has informed the house that fieldwork should not be done without toughpad.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>(Action: Smt Pinki Yadav, Supt Geologist)</b></p> <p><b>Shri G.J.S. Prasad</b> has informed the house that He has 3 GCM items. He also informed the house that officers in item no 24956 has been collected 18 Unit Cell samples and three water samples.In this reagard Director TC informed the house that officers alone cannot collected water sample and chemist should be requested to go to</p>

field for collecting water samples with proper collection methodology.

Shri G.J. S Prasad has informed the house that the item no. 25406 will be initiating from 22nd Sept,2019. He also informed that item no. 25409 will be initiated after getting vehicle order.

**Shri S. Venketeswara Rao, Supdtg. Geologist** has informed the house that he has two G2 MII items and 2 limestone items which has been requested to be dropped and one alternative item has to be proposed by the officers as soon as possible. Mr. Md. Zuhaib Siddiqui, Senior Geologist and Mr. Siba Sundar Sahu, Geologist has been requested to issue alternative proposals for each limestone items.

He also informed that the item in no. 25900 18.5 Sq km has been completed and 13 BRS samples has been submitted. In this regard he informed the item initiated in June and officer Mrs. Alakananda Priya Darshinee, Assistant Geologist has completed 19 field days.

He informed that item no. 25904 has been initiated in 10<sup>th</sup> May. DDG SU:AP informed the house that they should finalize the Map and samples data should be plotted and collected properly whenever they come to HQ.

**Sri Srinivasa Chowdary has informed the house that he has 4 nos. of item in Diamond exploration.** All the items have been initiated. DDG, SU:AP asked Sri Srinivas Chowdary to inform his officers to give IGC abstract regarding Monazite Mapping Data as the date of extended abstract has been extended upto 31<sup>st</sup> Oct,2019 engaged in item no 25864.

Sri Srinivasa Chowdary has informed that item no 25494 has started in May 2019, in which pitting, trenching and bulk sampling have been completed and sample processing is pending as RCA (Wages) has not been recouped in this item.

**Sri Apurba Banerjee** informed the house that he has 4 G4 items which has been started. Item in Bondapalle (25821) has already covered 10 sq km area and 5 BRS sampling has been done.

Item in Perapi (26971) has **completed** 10 sq km and 5 nos. of BRS has been done. In this regard he was instructed by DDG, SU:AP that not to give permission to his officers to come HQ before 40 days.

Item in Solipikonda (25462) has covered 0.4 sq km DM and 10 nos of BRS sampling has been done. Based on DM 1 BH is proposed and Drilling 449 has been shifted from Devada. He also informed that MRO problem is solved in this regard.

Shri Prasun Ghosh, Director informed the house three items ( G4) of Iron Ore exploration under his supervision has been initiated and drilling in G2 item in Obulapuram block could not be initiated as forest clearance is pending.

2.4.0	<p><b>Status of In-house and Out Source drilling:</b></p> <p>During discussion of In-house and Out Source drilling Shri Prasun Gosh, Director informed the house that there is one out source drilling in item in Veldurthy(25483) project. Regarding this <b>Shri Srikrishna Yadav</b> informed the house that drilling party has already visited the area. They have given feedback that there is no problem in drilling as the area is cultivation land but due to rainy season drilling can not be initiated right now.</p>
2.5.0	<p><b>Status of submission of Final reports for FS:2018-19:</b></p> <p>Sri Prasun Ghosh, Director appraised the matter regarding the submission of Final reports for FS 2018-19 that there are has 3 nos. of STM reports among which two reports of STM item ( item nos. 20536 and 15452 ) have been sent for Approval to RMH-I and the rest ( item no 15460) is with author for modification.</p> <p>He also informed that in FS 2018-19, there are 10 nos. of final reports of MII projects. Reports for Udaygri and Devada will be submitted on 12<sup>th</sup> Oct,2019 and 30<sup>th</sup> Nov,2019 respectively as decided during this meeting. Two reports (15646 and 15852) have been sent for approval and 6 nos of reports are with authors for modification after IPR till date.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>(Action :All concerned supervisory officers and all officers )</b></p>
2.6.0	<p><b>Administrative matter:</b></p> <p><b>Shri S. Venketeswara Rao, Supdtg. Geologist</b> requested the house to change the nodal officer of Bhuvisamvad. DDG , SU:AP requested all supervisory officers to interact with Shri S. Venketeswara Rao regarding implementation of VAQ.</p> <p>HO informed the house that RCA has been disbursed to all officers and RCA of limestone projects should be returned to office if the item is dropped.</p> <p>Regarding NGCM samples Shri T.K. Prabhakar, Suptdg. Chemist, Chemical Division, Southern Region informed the house that results of 77 projects are with chemical division right now. As per the orders given by CHQ, sample has been diverted to Laboratories in CHQ, Lakhnow and Faridabad for analysis. He also informed that all NGCM analysis of FS 2018-19 will be completed by January 2020.</p> <p><b>(Action :All concerned officers)</b></p>
