Sub: Guidelines for deployment of personnel (Geologists and Geophysicist) in Integrated Thematic Mapping items for FS 2019-20 - reg.

Sir,

This is to convey you that a standard guideline has been set for deployment of personnel for Integrated Thematic Mapping (ITM) items for FS 2019-20. Accordingly, 220 sq km of geological mapping and geophysical survey (gravity and magnetic) are to be assigned to 2 geologists (full time) and 2 geophysicists (part time) for ITM items of Himalayan Region and North-Eastern States. For all other regions a target of 350 sq km of geological mapping and geophysical survey (gravity and magnetic) are to be assigned to 2 geologists (full time) and 2 geophysicists (part time) for ITM items.

The guidelines are to be strictly adhered to for all the Integrated Thematic Mapping items including the approved items to be taken up in FS 2019-20.
