

**BRIEF NOTE ON ANNUAL STRATEGIC INTERACTION MEET, AIZAWL,
MIZORAM ON 16-04-2019.**

In pursuance of the MoM D.O.No.11/18/2019-M.I. dated 11th March, 2019, the Annual Strategic Interaction Meet-2019 was held on 16th April, 2019 at 10:30 hrs at the Conference Hall of the Chief Secretary, Govt. of Mizoram.

The meeting started with introduction of the Mulk Raj Jarngal, ADG and HoD, NER, GSI to the Chief Secretary, Govt. of Mizoram and presentation of Memento and publications of GSI like “Glimpses of Activities of the Geological Survey of India in Tripura and Mizoram”, “Geology and Mineral Resources of Manipur, Mizoram, Nagaland and Tripura” and brochures on Landslide Hazard Studies in NER, Meghalayan Age, Limestone as well as Coal Resources of NER. This was followed by a Powerpoint Presentation in which the ADG and HoD gave a brief introduction of GSI and a general overview of the work carried out by GSI with emphasis on Mizoram. A detailed presentation was then given by Dr. Tapan Pal, Director PSS regarding all the work done by GSI in Mizoram and Mission –wise future plan of GSI activity in Mizoram. The works related to societal issues attended by the GSI in Mizoram was discussed in detail. The ADG and HoD had informed the Chief Secretary that GSI is going to install DGPS station at Aizawl city shortly to which the Chief Secretary and the state officials present in the meeting appreciated. Discussion was also held on data sharing about the work carried out by GSI with the stakeholders through data sharing policy of GSI through OCBIS Portal where GSI reports under different missions, maps on various scales, NGCM data, publications etc could be accessed.

The Chief Secretary, Govt. of Mizoram requested GSI to carry out work like exploration for good quality dimension stones for construction materials in Mizoram. He also expressed interest to get Seismic Microzonation report of Aizawl town for Government of Mizoram. He was also concerned about the landslides in Mizoram and appreciated the work done by GSI on Macro-Scale Landslide Susceptibility Mapping and requested GSI to take additional items on Meso-scale landslide zonation mapping and site specific studies in future. He was keen to know about the importance of the study related to permanent DGPS station. Finally, the Chief Secretary expressed his appreciation to the contribution of GSI in Mizoram state and requested to spread public awareness of GSI activity through social media like press meet and local newspapers. The ADG and HoD informed that GSI will complete Macroscale landslide mapping by FS 2019-20 and will take care all the suggestions of Chief Secretary.
