1. The promotion will take effect from the date of assumption of charge to the post of Superintending Chemist in GSI by the officer concerned after communication of this Memorandum.
2. The pay of the officers' concerned in Pay Matrix Level - 12: Rs. 78,800 - 2,09,200 in GSI will be fixed according to rules. However, he/ she may exercise his/ her option in terms of FR 22(I)(a)(i) within 1 (one) month from the date of taking charge of promotion as Superintending Chemist.
3. He/ She has to undergo Promotion Linked Training (PLT) within 1 (one) year from the date of issue of this Memorandum and successful completion of such training is mandatory for continuance in the post in terms of the instructions/ guidelines laid down by DOPT/ MoM.
4. His/ Her continuance in the post will be considered in accordance with the instructions issued by the Government of India from time to time.
5. The inter-se-seniority of the promotees will be in the order of DPC empanelment as indicated above.
6. The promotion is subject to the outcome of the pending court cases, if any having bearing on him.

If he/ she is willing to accept the offer of promotion on the above terms & conditions, he/ she may take charge to the post of Superintending Chemist at the place of posting on promotion
